Our Community

- Buffalo Hart is an unincorporated community in northern Sangamon County.
- Buffalo Hart township has a population of 222.
- Most members of our church live within a 15 mile radius of the church. Residing in Buffalo Hart township, Buffalo, Dawson, Mechanicsburg, Riverton, Sherman, Springfield and Williamsville.
- We are located 10 miles northeast of Springfield.



Our mission is to provide a spiritual home where believers gather to worship and glorify God in all three persons. We seek to fulfill the Bible's Great Commission to go and make disciples, in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.



Our Vision is rooted in Christian fellowship, as we open our doors, our minds and our hearts to our community, in both love and service. The Bible calls its faithful to lovingly work, teach and lead as the hands and feet of Jesus.

What We Believe

We believe, teach and confess Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterian (ECO) essential tenets and are guided in that belief.

Ministries

Our worship service typically consists of a standard traditional Order of Worship. We hold one service on Sunday, 9:30 to 10:30 am, with piano-accompanied traditional hymns. We have a high-grade sound system and two pianos – traditional and electric.

Ministry details:

- Communion is shared approximately 15 times per year: the first Sunday of each month, Christmas Eve service, Holy Week service and Funk's Grove service.
- Four dedicated volunteer musicians, with occasional special music from congregants.
- We currently hold a music copyright license.
- Sunday School for toddlers thru 5th grade held weekly during the morning worship service. An average of 8 children attend, and 10 adults rotate teaching Sunday school lessons.
- Adult Sunday School led by the pastor is held weekly prior to morning worship service.
- Bible studies for Lenten and Advent seasons.
- Vacation Bible school inviting children from the community. Average of 25 children attending, and ten volunteers serving this mission.
- Women's group meets monthly.
- Additional fellowship includes: all-birthday potluck, attending Springfield minor league baseball game, Funk's Grove evening potluck and church service, game night, ice cream sundae night, and paint night.



Community Outreach

Buffalo Hart Presbyterian Church reaches beyond its church family to connect with the community in service and ministry.

- Each summer, a community picnic is held for the Buffalo Hart residents, church attendees, and those with a family history to the area, co-sponsored with the township.
- Monthly book group discussions, open to the community.
- Updated web site and Facebook presence.

Missions we support

We support several non-profit organizations.

Fifth Sunday Ministries:

In the months with five Sundays, usually four times per year, the congregation collects food and monetary donations. We support two food pantries, Riverton Food Pantry and Tri-City Food Pantry. Additionally, the Women's Association prepares and serves an evening meal at Helping Hands of Springfield to clients who are experiencing homelessness.

Other ministries:

- Year-long collection of consumables for Helping Hands of Springfield.
- Assistance to local schools, supplies for school nurse, consumables (Kleenex, Items for emergency clothing closet).
- Baby layette collection, in cooperation with Church Women United in Springfield, distributed to Kumler Neighborhood Ministries.
- Generous end-of-year benevolences to Springfield area social agencies, area food pantries, Kemmerer Village and Illinois Presbyterian Home.





Buffalo Hart Presbyterian Church Profile





Brief History

Early 1800's	Settlement of Buffalo Hart Grove began.
1826	First recorded church service took place in the home of Mr. and Mrs. James Lynn.
1832	A Chapel was constructed about a mile south of our current church location, serving all residents regardless of religious affiliation.
1859	Sunday school was organized and held at the Chapel.
1867	Buffalo Hart Union Church was built by the area Christians, Baptists, Methodists and Presbyterians. It was located about two miles south of Buffalo Hart.
1896	The Presbyterians from the Union Church petitioned the Presbytery to organize a Presbyterian church at Buffalo Hart. The church was formally organized in May. Sunday school thrived and attendance was high each week.

1900	The congregation decided to build a new church at Buffalo Hart Station, where it stands today. The new church was dedicated in October.
1923	The Ladies Aid Society paid \$385, which was the balance of the original \$500 mortgage. The Buffalo Hart Presbyterian Church has remained debt-free since then.
1947	Vacation Bible school was started with 102 children attending.
1957-61	Three rooms were added to the original structure and many interior improvements were made including indoor plumbing.
1992	By this time membership had dwindled to less than 30 and Sunday attendance was low. Through some "divine interventions" and steady pulpit supply, which began in June 1993, the congregation was energized, stabilized and began to grow. This was also the first year the church received a distribution from a generous trust fund. This money permitted extensive updating and improvements.
1996	In the fall, the 100 th birthday of the congregation's founding was celebrated.
2007	Additional rooms, including a kitchen and expanded fellowship area were added and dedicated – with no debt.
2021	The congregation decided to leave the Presbyterian Church (USA) and joined ECO.

Our Church Today

Present Today we stand strongly as a loving and giving congregation of 66

members, 25 to 30 friends of the church with an average Sunday attendance of 50. We intend to continue to be a cherished beacon of light and hope in the rural community, in the true belief that God can

do so much with so little.

Staff: Buffalo Hart Presbyterian Church employees a solo pastor and a part time custodian.

Leadership: Church leadership consists of a Session comprised of nine Elders and three Deacons, along with committee liaisons, members, and a robust volunteer corps.
